

#### Introduction

The OWI **AMP-HD AMPLIFIER** is a three source integratable self-powered speaker/amplifier. This amplifier can drive Four (4) - 80hm speakers connected parallel. With an included UL Listed, **Level 5** (Energy Star), 15-volt, 3.5 ampere power supply, the amplifier can output 40 watts, or 10 watts per speaker in a four-speaker hook-up.

#### Special features of the OWI AMP-HD AMPLIFIER include:

- Three (3) audio inputs: Stereo 3.5 Mini Jack Line Input, Balanced Line Input, proprietary Cat 5 input for OWI Products only
- **Input # 1** Stereo 3.5 Mini Jack Line Input The JACK LINE IN accepts unbalanced input via 3.5 mini jack. The stereo channels are summed together. This input is muted when the Priority Override is in use.
- Input # 2 Balanced Line Input -The LINE IN inputs accepts a balanced input via a Phoenix style screw terminal plug. This also is and has the *Priority Override Feature connected to it.* The Priority input accepts balanced input levels 1-volt (approximately line level) audio and Speaker level at 1 watt or less. Audio on the Priority input suspends audio on the 3.5 mini jack and Cat 5 Inputs and switches the speaker amplifier to pass the Priority audio. After the Priority audio stops, the unit waits before returning to the Line In and Jack Line In audio input.
- Input # 3 Cat 5 input Proprietary Cat 5 input for OWI Products only.

  Use only with another OWI AMP-HD or HD AMP SPEAKER, OWI MC4, OWI BTVC, AMPSTVCW and Future OWI models.
- Priority Override Paging (POP) The POP controls are the POP Trigger level and the POP Volume level
- POP Volume Level The POP Volume level is the level at which the speaker will play the POP Message. This level can be set from Zero to MAX
- POP Trigger Level Adjust this by rotating it from more to less sensitive. If this is too low it will not trigger the controller to switch. If it is set too high it will constantly stay on and not go back to the needed setting.

#### **Switches**

POP / ALL SOURCES MIXED SWITCH – When the amplifier is going to be used in a Priority Override mode place the switch to the Priority Override

Line Level/Speaker Level Switch - This is for the Priority Override input #2

### **Balanced Line Level Output**

- OUTPUT # 1 A nominal 0dB level, balanced output is available at LINE OUT. The source of this output is a balanced Line Output via a Phoenix style screw terminal plug.
- OUTPUT # 2 Cat 5 output Proprietary Cat 5 output for connecting or stacking another OWI AMP speaker. This carries both the power and the signal to the next amplifier.

## Power Amplifier Features

The power amplifier outputs **2 times 20 watts or 40 watts total into 8 ohms** and 15VDC power. The class D power amplifier has reduced radiated electromagnetic interference (EMI) due to a special feature of the power amplifier, operating in a patented spread spectrum. The power amplifier protects itself from over-temperature, over-current, over-voltage conditions. The power amplifier will shut itself down during these conditions.

IMPORTANT NOTE! This amplifier is intended for audio use only! Continuous sine wave drive into a load will cause the amplifier to shut itself down when it heats up.

PS15VDC35AL5 Grounding Illustration











## **Chained Self Amplified Speakers Wiring**




## One, Two, Four Speaker Combination Wiring




## INPUT CONNECTORS WIRING

Note: Jack Line In is the same as STEREO LINE IN, immediately below.





# **OWI AMP-HD-602 WIRING DIAGRAM**




CAT5 Cable to input of the amplifier







# **OWI AMP-HD-2GBFP WIRING DIAGRAM**




# **OWI AMP-HD WIRING DIAGRAM**



## For projects requiring integration with 25/70/100-Volt line from paging systems:

- Transformer will be wired from the factory with the Ohm leads connected to the Priority Override Page (POP) Balanced Input and the selector switch positioned to SPK LVL (Speaker Level)
- 2. Connect 25/70/100-volt line to 1/2W 1W tap setting



## See diagram:

- 3. Adjust volume to adequate level before distortion to sound the speaker or to lowest volume (spinning to left) to mute speaker.
- 4. Adjust the trim to activate the override feature sensitivity.

## INSTALLATION

NOTE: Installation is to be completed by a qualified electrical technician according to NEC/CEC code and applicable local codes.

## **Speaker Placement**

Before installing your OWI speakers, consider the placement carefully, taking into effect the location of electrical, plumbing and other fixtures.

## **Placement On the Wall or Ceiling**

OWI speakers should be located at the primary listening area.

## **Mounting your OWI speakers**

Determine the best area to mount your OWI speakers. It will be necessary to run your speaker wires to that location. This location must be free of obstructions, such as electrical conduits, HVAC ducts, or water lines.

Route the speaker wires from your amplifier to your opening. Avoid routing the speaker wire near electrical wires. If you have to run them parallel, make certain to space the speaker wires at least 2 feet from the AC line. Do not nail or staple the speaker wire.
